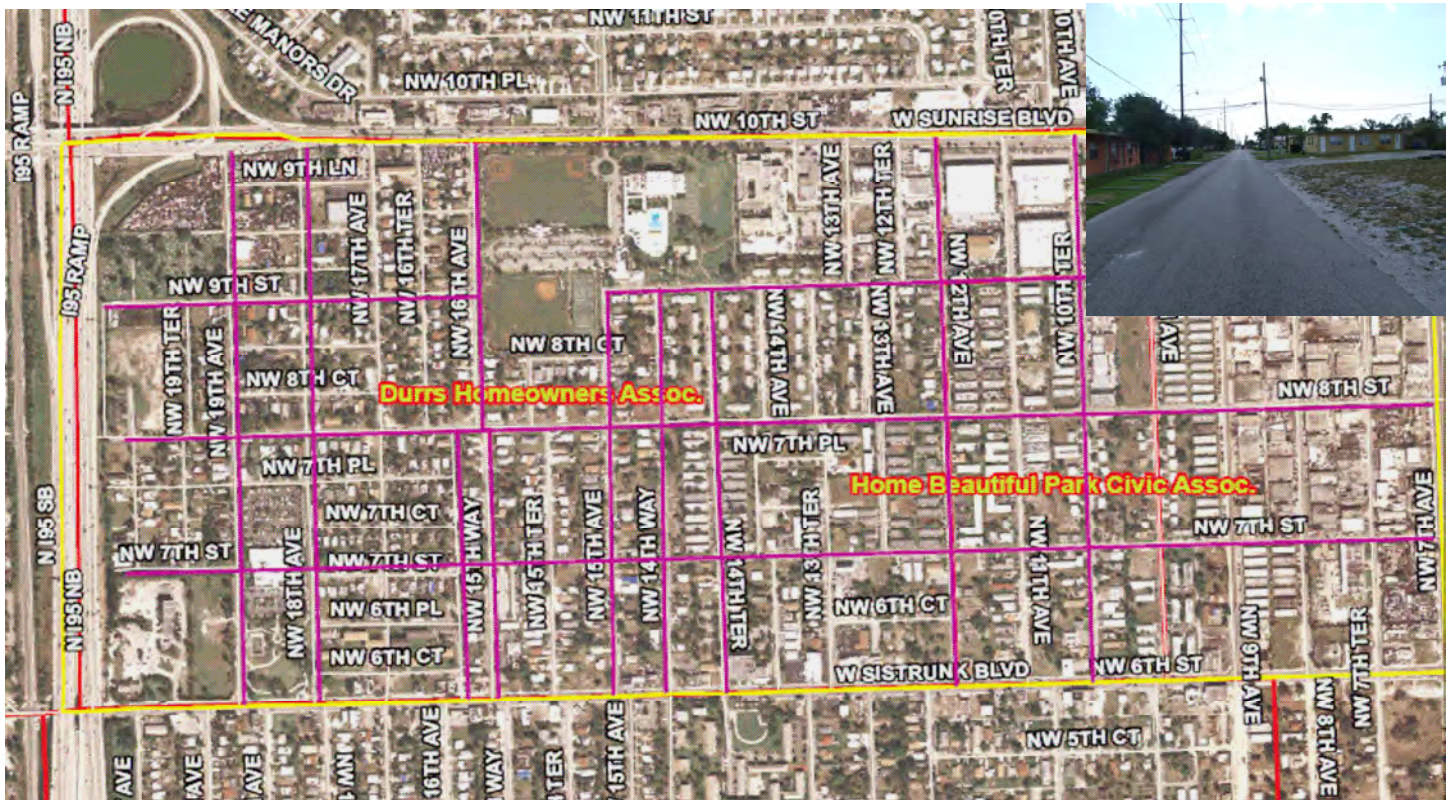


NW NEIGHBORHOOD ENHANCEMENT PROJECT



Project Scope and Summary

NW Neighborhood Enhancement project is a neighborhood pedestrian safety and beautification project, which consists of sidewalk and ADA access, traffic calming, pedestrian lighting system and landscaping improvements within the Durrs and Home Beautiful Park neighborhood roads. The limit of this project is NMW 9th Avenue on the east, I-95 to the west, Sistrunk Boulevard to the south and Sunrise Boulevard to the north.

These underserved Front Porch designated communities have been served by the Broward County Transit and is in need of pedestrian access and safety improvements. The proposed NW Neighborhood Enhancement project Improvements are based on the Northwest/Progresso/Flagler Heights Implementation Plan dated February 2008. This plan was generated with extended public participation and focus groups with the community stakeholders to identify the issues within the community and to create a vision for the community.

The design and construction documents for the NW Neighborhood Enhancement project have been completed embracing the Livable Community Standards and the institution of Traffic Calming Elements.

Due to the cost and grant funding available this project will be designed and constructed in Phases.
